#### **Election Success!**

Over 100 HCEA volunteers braved chilly, rainy weather on November 7th to distribute the approximately 35,000 HCEA Apple Ballot to prospective voters. Our efforts were rewarded as 17 of our 20 endorsed candidates were elected, among them the county executive, four county council positions, four school board positions, and all senators and delegates in legislative districts 12 and 13.

HCEA poll workers reported that many voters, who wanted no other campaign materials, took the Apple Ballot. Others came to the polls and specifically requested the "teacher list" of endorsements. Our endorsed candidates appreciated our efforts. Several chose to forego handing out their own individual campaign pieces and handed out only our Apple Ballot. Many said the Apple Ballot made the difference in their election.

### **Mentoring Grows**

Expanding mentoring support for new teachers has been a top HCEA goal this past year. The HCEA Professional Development Committee met with HCPSS staff several times to advocate for additional mentors and to encourage additional mentoring training for those in teacher-support positions.

Advocacy by HCEA and our members, and increased support from HCPSS administration is bearing fruit in terms of expanded mentoring. A four-day HCPSS mentoring conference was held on October 24-27. The primary audience for the conference were current mentors, elementary reading and math support teachers and secondary Math Instructional Support Teacher (MIST). The nationally recognized expertise reflected in training leadership and materials is another step toward HCEA's goal of mentor support for all new teachers.

### **HCEA-ESP Negotiations Update**

The HCEA-ESP Bargaining Team met with the Board of Education's team for the first time on Monday evening, November 20th. Both sides exchanged proposals and provided clarification on each of the items proposed. The HCEA-ESP proposals were developed from the ESP bargaining surveys conducted last spring and this fall, as well as from input from individuals and groups within the bargaining unit. Anyone interested in seeing the proposals may review them at the HCEA office. The next meeting of the two parties will take place on Wednesday evening, December 20th.
